As you know, Har-Bur Middle School needed to close last Thursday to contact trace because of a positive Covid Case. We want you to know that we are prepared to continue with teaching and learning if it should happen again. Below is the Emergency School Closure Schedule if the school building is closed. All classes would meet virtually, and teachers will be communicating this schedule to students and review how to log on for virtually learning. **This schedule will be followed by all students including those that are in are Opt-Out DL Program to ensure teacher availability.**

Students are not expected to be online during L-Block **unless a student received specialized services during that time.** Core academic teachers will be available to help support students during that time.

Regarding attendance, if a student cannot participate in classes please contact with Mrs. Niedmann (Grades 7 and 8) at ext. 17507 or Mrs. Belmonte (Grades 5 and 6) at ext. 17310 as these are school days and not being able to participate is equivalent to being absent from school. In addition, please remind your children that they need to keep their video on during class unless given permission to turn it off by the teacher.

It is our hope that we will not need to close again but we wanted to share this important information with you about what would happen if it did occur. We are continuing to reinforce the health and safety protocols that we have in place so that everyone stays healthy. Families, we appreciate the measures that you are taking at home to help with this as well.
