CONNECTION

Let's take a look at one of the claims that we came up with for Squeaky, in *Raymond's Run*.

Turn and Talk:

- *What do you notice about the three reasons?*
- Now, let's take a close look at the first reason. Let's skim through the story to find some strong text evidence that can support that claim.

ACTIVE ENGAGEMENT

Now, go back to your seats and skim through *Raymond's Run*, searching for text evidence that supports the second and third reasons.

- On a sticky note, write one strong piece of evidence that can support either of those two reasons.
- Place that sticky note on the chart paper next to the reason it supports.
